Research, writing, and presentation assignments have enhanced their ability to gather, analyze, and present information, and group projects have developed their skills at communication and cooperative work.</p> <p>This training is important to employers which is reflected in the competitive salary offers that graduates with a degree in business administration often receive when they enter the job market.
