Graduation Rates

The graduation rate as reported to IPEDs for only first-time, full-time students who started between the timeframe of September 1, 2013 through August 31, 2014 and completed their program of study within 150% of the normal projected timeframe is 40%. The table below provides the graduation rates by gender, ethnicity, and receipt/non-receipt of Federal student financial aid.

Retention Rates

The retention rate as reported to IPEDs each year is for bachelor's degree students only and includes first-time, full-time students who began their program of study in Fall 2018 (August 1, 2018 – October 31, 2018) and are still enrolled or who have completed their studies as of the end of Fall 2019: August 1, 2019) year. The retention rate for that cohort is provided in the table below.
